This show utilizes specific rose show rules and uses American Rose Society approved judges. Participation is open to the public. It is a free to enter, and easy to enter. If you have a rose or roses you'd like to show from your garden, cut the longest stem(s) you can, put it in water and bring to the American Legion Hall between 7:00 to 10 a.m. on September 26. If you have never entered a rose show, there will be TARS members to help you prepare them for judging; just ask for help. You MUST know the name of the rose and proper spelling of the rose. We will have an arrangement challenge! If you are interested in preparing your prettiest floral arrangement of roses and other flowers grown from your garden, then bring it to the American Legion Hall where you can put it together. There will also be a Photography Challenge. Your photos must be printed to the 8 1/2 x 11 size and you must know the rose. You will frame your pictures in at black matt which we provide, for display. It is easy to do; just bring your named roses, and we will help you enter the show.



September 26 Schedule

- 7:00 - 10:00 a.m. Prepare roses for show; place on tables by 10 a.m.
- 10:00 - 12:00 p.m. Judging by American Rose Society Judges
- 12:00 - 1:00 p.m. Lunch (provided for judges, workers and those showing roses)
- 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. Open to the public for viewing and voting on the People's Choice Award
